




Electrical work

Any electrical work is at extra cost

In accordance with present regulations, if any electrical work is carried out in your bathroom, the consumer unit circuit to the bathroom must have 30mA rcd protection. Your water and gas services must have a main bond (must be correctly earthed). If the house does not meet these regulations, work would need to be carried out to meet them prior to any other electric work being carried out. This will be confirmed before any work is carried out.

We do not add electrical work to the package price as each person chooses a different selection of electrical products. Electrical work will be charged separately by the electrician.






Diagram and Floor Plan

The diagram is for illustration purposes only. It is not to scale. It shows a floor plan and provides an idea of the bathroom layout. It is possible that the bathroom items may be fitted is slightly different positions which will be determined by the fabric of the building such as, waste and water pipes, soil pipe, floor joists, windows, doors and heating pipes. When fitting we will make decision of the best location for items to be fitted that may not have been obvious at the time of creating the drawing.

Thermostatic showers and heating systems

Thermostatic showers can only be fitted when then hot water is taken from a high pressure system such as a combination boiler. If your hot water is taken from a low pressure system such as Immersion tank, it will not be possible to fit a thermostatic shower; The alternative is the fitting of an electric shower (this is at an extra cost).

The basin mixer (sink tap) requires a high pressure system to operate correctly. It is possible to fit this tap to a low pressure system, though the hot water flow will be limited based on the hot water pressure from your system.

If you have an old heating system we strongly recommend that you invest in a new heating system before upgrading your bathroom.

Boiler and Heating System





When tiling bathroom walls, we need to first remove any radiator within the bathroom. To enable this we need to drain the heating system (remove water from the radiator). On refitting your radiator or replacing it with a towel warmer, we will top up the heating system. On occasions after a drain down, heating systems will not work without a service. This must be carried out by a gas engineer. We cannot carry out this work or be liable for any costs incurred.

We do not decorate


We do not undertake any decorating of the ceiling, door or architrave around the door.

If there is architrave around the door we will tile to it, however if the level of the tile is higher we will add a tile trim to the edge

Stopcock and Gatevalve

At some point during the refit of your bathroom, we will need to turn off the water to the property using the stopcock. In some instances the stopcock fails as it has seized internally and will not allow the water to shut off, alternatively after turning the stopcock it may begin to leak. If this occurs we cannot be held responsible.

We will be able to carry out the work to replace the stopcock or gatevalve at the price of the material and labour charged at £20 per hour.



Toilet

Every day 6pm till 7:30am the toilet will be usable. We will refit a toilet every evening before we leave.

The toilet will not be usable or certain days and may not be usable on later days thought the work.

The toilet may be on a bucket flush for some of the time.
